RULES AND REGULATIONS

HOTEL RESERVATIONS

Exhibitors and sponsors who need hotel accommodations must book at the OPMA contract hotel under the Oregon Podiatric Medical Association room block. Any representative or company who violates this requirement will forfeit their exhibit space and/or sponsorship and will not be allowed to participate in future OPMA conferences or events.

PRODUCTS/SERVICES EXHIBITED

Products or services exhibited or referred to must be those related to the interests and educational values of the Oregon Podiatric Medical Association ("OPMA") and normally manufactured or supplied by the Exhibitor. Exhibitor may exhibit only those products/services approved by the OPMA. The OPMA may refuse to accept the Application of any company or person whose display of goods or services is not compatible, in the sole opinion of the OPMA, with the general character and objectives of the OPMA.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Exhibit space is not reserved until payment is received in full by the OPMA. Exhibit space canceled on or before June 1, 2026 will be refunded all but \$200.00 of the exhibit space fee paid. No refunds will be processed after June 1, 2026. No exceptions. Cancellations must be made by email to the OPMA at info@orpma.org. Refunds will not be issued to no shows.

NON-COMPETE

Exhibitors and sponsors are prohibited from scheduling receptions, dinners, hospitality suites, social functions, product demonstrations, technical seminars, training sessions or other events for individuals attending the Oregon Foot & Ankle Conference ("Conference") from October 22, 2026 at 12:00 AM to October 24, 2026 at 6:00 PM without the written consent of the OPMA. Exhibitors and Sponsors must send their request by email to the OPMA at info@orpma.org. The OPMA has sole and absolute discretion to deny any such written request.

FDA REGULATIONS

Exhibitors shall comply with all applicable Food and Drug Administration (FDA) regulations, including, without limitation, FDA restrictions on the promotion of investigational and preapproved drugs and devices and the FDA prohibition on promoting approved drugs and devices for unapproved uses. Any product not FDA-approved for a particular use or not commercially available in the US may be exhibited only if accompanied by easily visible signs indicating the status of the product.

LIABILITY

The Exhibitor hereby assumes responsibility and agrees to indemnify and defend the OPMA, its officers, members, independent contractors, or staff, and the Oregon Convention Center, its respective officers, owners, agents, members, employees, affiliates, parents, insurers, predecessors, successors, or assigns, against claims or expenses arising out of the use of the exhibition premises, unless the damage or injury is due solely to the willful misconduct of the OPMA or the Oregon Convention Center. The Exhibitor further waives any and all rights it may have against the OPMA and its respective directors, officers, members, agents, employees, independent contractors and successors, and releases and discharges them from any claim relating to Exhibitor's occupancy and use of the exhibit area, or any part thereof.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

INSURANCE

All property of the Exhibitor is understood to remain under its custody and control in transit to and from and within the confines of the exhibit area. The OPMA and the Oregon Convention Center do not provide insurance covering Exhibitor's property, and Exhibitor expressly waives and releases any claim or demand it may have against them by reason of any damage to or loss of property of the Exhibitor.

CANCELLATION

In the event the Conference shall be canceled for any reason whatsoever, then and thereupon the contract for exhibit space with Exhibitor shall be terminated. In such case, the Exhibitor shall waive all damages and claims for damages and agrees that the sole liability of the OPMA will be to return to the Exhibitor their space payment on a pro rata basis after deduction of all conference related costs and expenses incurred by the OPMA through the date of cancellation, in addition to an administrative fee, and overhead charges.

OTHER REGULATIONS

The OPMA shall have the sole authority to interpret and enforce all Rules and Regulations governing Exhibitors at the Conference. Any and all matters not specifically covered herein are subject to decision by the OPMA. These Rules and Regulations may be amended at any time by the OPMA upon written notice to all Exhibitors. Each Exhibitor expressly agrees to be bound by the Rules and Regulations set forth herein and by any amendments thereto adopted by the OPMA from time to time. Any Exhibitor or Exhibitor representative who, in the sole discretion of the OPMA, conducts itself unethically may immediately be dismissed from the conference without refund or other appeal.

VIOLATION OF RULES

Any violation of these Rules and Regulations by Exhibitor may, in the OPMA's sole discretion, result in denial of access to the exhibit area, denial of exhibit space installation, closing or removal of the Exhibitor's exhibit space, and/or prohibition on future participation in the Conference. In the event Exhibitor violates the Rules and Regulations and is prohibited from continued use of the exhibit space, Exhibitor's exhibit space fee, or any portion of it, is nonrefundable.

APPLICABLE LAWS

This contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Oregon. Exhibitor shall abide by these Rules and Regulations, as well as any rules or regulations of the venue, and all applicable local, state, and federal laws or other laws, rules and regulations.

SEVERABILITY

Should any part of this contract be found by a court of law to be void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
